Book Illustrators Gallery (BIG)

The Book Illustrators Gallery, part of Asian Festival of Children's Content (AFCC) aims to showcase local and regional illustrators and artists and promote them to a wider audience. It offers a platform for the authors, publishers and the public to take notice of your illustrations. The BIG is available for viewing from 14 May to 3 June 2016, except on 21 May 2016 (Saturday), a public holiday in Singapore.

Who Can Apply:

- 1. Illustrators whose artwork that has been featured in children's books, audio/video products, comics or graphic novels published between January 2015 and March 2016.
- 2. Illustrators who have prepared a **completed unpublished** manuscript for a picture book.

Submissions Guidelines:

These guidelines apply to both published and unpublished children's book illustrations.

- Each applicant is allowed to submit a maximum of five pieces of illustration. Please do not reenter the same illustration submitted to BIG in previous years.
- Please send <u>one</u> high resolution and <u>one</u> thumbnail sized digital copies in jpeg/jpg format to <u>afccbig@bookcouncil.sg</u> with the email subject "AFCC BIG 2016 Submission".
- The organizer will also accept unpublished illustrations. Applicants are invited to submit illustrations with the story.
- Applicants who submitted their illustrations for BIG 2015 can apply with new illustrations for BIG 2016.
- Each applicant may submit a maximum of three illustrations from each book title and a total of five illustrations from two or more book titles.
- **Please do not send/post the original illustration**. The organiser will not be responsible for any loss or damage to the illustration.
- The size of the exhibited illustration range from A5 A2. Illustrations will be mounted by the organiser for display. The printing, mounting and venue costs will be borne by the organiser. By submitting your illustration, you agree to allow the organiser to use a reproduction of your illustration in the publicity for AFCC, either online or in printed materials.
- If your illustration is selected, we strongly encourage you to create your publicity plan to create awareness for exhibition of your illustration. Your printed illustration may be used in NBDCS's programmes.
- Applicants whose illustrations are selected will be entitled to the 3-day pass AFCC Writers & Illustrators conference at a special ticket price of S\$ 200 (usual price: S\$ 350).
